

Split Scene Pattern

Tip for cutting wide scenic print center rectangle:

- Follow the first 2 steps in the pattern to cut the top and bottom outer borders.

- From the remaining yardage, select the 38"-wide x 43"-tall rectangle that you want to use in the center of the quilt. Use masking tape to outline the rectangle or trace around it with a pencil or fine-tip marker.

- Continue with the remaining cutting steps in the pattern to cut the side borders and binding. *If the outlined rectangle is too close to the left or right edges of the fabric to cut all strips indicated, just cut the strips that you can from the edge and then move to the other side of the rectangle and continue cutting the remaining strips for that edge.*

- Cut out the center rectangle.

- Set aside the remainder of the fabric to lengthen the side borders, if necessary. See steps 2 and 3 of Completing the Quilt.

You may choose a completely different section of the print than we did to use in the center of your quilt. There is plenty of fabric to make it your own masterpiece!
