

## Corrections for Walk Through the Garden pattern:

Cream mottled cutting, last step: change to **2** strips 1 1/2" x WOF for sashing.

Piecing the blocks, step 7: change to "Sew EF segments to the cream edges of each **G** segment,"

**Completing the Quilt:** Replace steps 1–5 of the original pattern with the following:

**1. Rows 1 and 4:** Paying close attention to the positioning of the blocks, sew 2 X blocks and 1 Y block together with (2) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" cream strips to make the 12 1/2" x 38 1/2" row 1 block strip. Press seams toward the cream strips. Add a 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" cream strip to the bottom edge as shown. Press seam toward the strip. Stitch a J triangle to the bottom end to complete Row 1. Press seam toward the triangle. Repeat to make Row 4 **except** sew the 38 1/2" cream strip to the top edge of the block strip and the J triangle to the top end.

**2.** Stitch the 1 1/2" x WOF cream sashing strips short ends together to make a long strip. Press seams to 1 side. Trim to 51 1/2".

**3. Rows 2 and 3:** Sew 1 X block, 2 Y blocks and 1 I square together with (3) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" cream strips to make the 12 1/2" x 51 1/2" row 2 block strip. Press seams toward the strips. Stitch the 51 1/2" cream strip to the bottom edge of the strip to complete Row 2. Press seam toward the cream strip. Repeat to make Row 3 **except** there is no long cream strip on the edge of the block strip.

**4.** Stitch Rows 1–4 together to complete the center section. Press seams to the long cream strip edges.

**5.** Sew a 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" cream strip to 1 edge of 2 of the remaining X blocks to make (2) 12 1/2" x 13 1/2" Corner blocks, positioning the block as shown. Press seam toward the strip. Repeat with the 2 remaining X blocks to make 2 Reverse Corner blocks, turning the block as shown.

**6.** Stitch J triangles to opposite sides of the Corner and Reverse Corner blocks. Press seams toward the triangles. Add a K triangle to the short side of each pieced strip to complete 2 each 28 1/2" x 28 1/2" x 40 1/4" corner units (C) and reverse corner (CR) units. Press seam toward the triangle. *Set aside the remaining J triangles for another project.*

**7.** Center and sew a corner (C) unit or reverse corner (CR) unit to each angled edge of the center section to complete the 55 3/4" x 74" quilt center. Press seams toward the corner units. *There will be approximately 1" of white beyond the outside corners of the blocks. This is correct. Do not trim.*

**Continue with step 6 of the original pattern to add borders and finish the quilt.**
